



Château Haut-Marbuzet 2014 Saint-Estèphe – Cru Bourgeois

Chateau Haut-Marbuzet was founded in the 18th century, taking its name from Marbuzet, the sector where the property resides. Chateau Haut Marbuzet was established by Alexander de Segur, who owned a myriad of Bordeaux wine properties including another, much better known St. Estephe vineyard, Calon Segur. At his death, the land was divided and sold. In fact a portion of the vineyards became a part of Le Crock. In 1825, the land was purchased by the MacCarthy family, who officially established what became Haut Marbuzet.

40% merlot
50% cabernet sauvignon
5% Cabernet Franc
5% Petit Verdot

SERVICE TEMPERATURE

16-18°C

TASTING NOTES

With cedar wood, earth and dark berries, this soft, round-textured, medium-bodied wine is forward in style and finishes with soft ripe cherries.

WINEMAKING

Vinification takes place in large oak vats. Malolactic fermentation takes place in vat. The wine is then aged in 100% new, French oak barrels for close to 18 months before bottling.
