



LE VIN DES NOCESDOMAINE LES ROQUES DE CANA 2008

Heir of the Eminée written by Virgil in the 1st century BC. JC, the Malbec grape was reputed to be the best wine of the Roman Empire at the time of Jesus. Cahors has made its vine for over 2000 years. Single vineyard to be replanted in Gaul on the order of the Emperor Probus in the third century, the Cahors was for François 1er "the world's best wine."

Les Roques de Cana, wine estate created by Martial Guiette and 24 other passionate partners is today the symbol of this search for excellence.

TERROIR

Clay-limestone

WINEMAKING

The vines are operated in viticulture with a thinning towards the sun rising in the grapes, allowing the gorge of sun in the early morning hours, thus promoting the evaporation of the morning dew. Yields were 20 hectoliters per hectare.

GRAPE VARIETY

80% Malbec 20% Merlot

ALCOHOL

14%

SERVICE TEMPERATURE

16 - 18 °C

TASTING NOTES

Deep and intense purple color turning to black. Intense nose of red fruits like cassis, blackberries. soft and greedy attack, mouth full of coated and structured tannins. tender and powerful wine.

FOOD PAIRING

Game, red meat, duck stews, roasted roe deer and cassoulet.
