



## Château Montgrand-Milon Pauillac - 2015

Château Montgrand Milon is made at Chateau Fonbadet, which is situated in the north of the small village of St. Lambert in Pauillac, close to the banks of the Gironde river. In the Middle Ages, the estate was owned by Chateau Latour, until the current owners, the Peyronnie family, bought it at the beginning of the 20th century. The vineyards are located in Bordeaux, including Château Mouton-Rothschild and Château Latour.

The vines are over 50 years old, planted on gravel and sandy soils at a density of 10,000 vines per hectare. The vines are double-stranded and planted on gentle slopes, with all harvesting done by hand.

The palate is well balanced, with silky tannins, fresh acidity, concentrated fruit and a lifted finish. It is rare to find a Pauillac that is both affordable and approachable.
